A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to a request for a customer record of a financial

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 59.006(a), Finance Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (a) This section provides the exclusive method for
- 8 compelled discovery of a record of a financial institution relating
- 9 to one or more customers but does not create a right of privacy in a
- 10 record. This section does not apply to and does not require or
- 11 authorize a financial institution to give a customer notice of:
- 12 (1) a demand or inquiry from a state or federal
- 13 government agency authorized by law to conduct an examination of
- 14 the financial institution;
- 15 (2) a record request from a state or federal
- 16 government agency or instrumentality under statutory or
- 17 administrative authority that provides for, or is accompanied by, a
- 18 specific mechanism for discovery and protection of a customer
- 19 record of a financial institution, including a record request from
- 20 a federal agency subject to the Right to Financial Privacy Act of
- 21 1978 (12 U.S.C. Section 3401 et seq.), as amended, or from the
- 22 Internal Revenue Service under Section 1205, Internal Revenue Code
- 23 of 1986;
- 24 (3) a record request from or report to a government

- 1 agency arising out of the investigation or prosecution of a
- 2 criminal offense or the investigation of alleged abuse, neglect, or
- 3 exploitation of an elderly or disabled person in accordance with
- 4 Chapter 48, Human Resources Code;
- 5 (4) a record request in connection with a garnishment
- 6 proceeding in which the financial institution is garnishee and the
- 7 customer is debtor;
- 8 (5) a record request by a duly appointed receiver for
- 9 the customer;
- 10 (6) an investigative demand or inquiry from a state
- 11 legislative investigating committee;
- 12 (7) an investigative demand or inquiry from the
- 13 attorney general of this state as authorized by law other than the
- 14 procedural law governing discovery in civil cases; [or]
- 15 (8) the voluntary use or disclosure of a record by a
- 16 financial institution subject to other applicable state or federal
- 17 law; or
- 18 (9) a record request in connection with an
- 19 investigation conducted under Section 1054.151, 1054.152, or
- 20 <u>1102.001</u>, Estates Code.
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 2014.
