A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

relating to the certification of sheriffs and deputy sheriffs to enforce commercial motor vehicle safety standards in certain 1-17 1-18 1-19 counties.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-21 SECTION 1. Section 644.101(c), Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-22 1-23 (c) A sheriff or a deputy sheriff of a county bordering the 1-24 United Mexican States or of a county with a population of one [2.2]1-25 million or more is eligible to apply for certification under this 1-26 section.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 1-27 1-28 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 1-29 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-30 1-31 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
