- Sec. 171.051. PHYSICIAN REPORTING REQUIREMENTS. (a) A 8
- 9 physician who performs an abortion at an abortion facility licensed
- under Chapter 245 must complete and submit to the department a 10
- 11 monthly report on each abortion performed by the physician at the
- 12 facility. The report must be submitted on a form provided by the
- 13 department.

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- 14 (b) The report may not identify by any means the patient

- 18 (d) Not later than the 15th day of each month, a physician
- shall submit by any means in which the receipt may be acknowledged 19

- 23 Sec. 171.052. PENALTIES. (a) The commissioner of state
- health services may assess an administrative penalty against a 24

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- 1 physician who fails to submit the physician report required by
- 2 Section 171.051 in the time specified under that section. The
- 3 amount of the penalty is \$1,000 for the first 30-day period or
- 4 portion of a 30-day period the report remains overdue, \$2,500 for
- 5 the second 30-day period, and \$5,000 for each 30-day period
- 6 thereafter.
- 7 (b) The commissioner of state health services shall bring an
- 8 action against a physician who fails to file the report required by
- 9 Section 171.051 on or before six months after the date the report
- 10 was due to compel the physician to submit a complete report in the
- 11 time ordered by the court or be subject to sanctions for civil
- 12 <u>contempt.</u>
- 13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
