- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 41.152(b), Agriculture Code, is amended 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (b) The council shall be the certified organization to plan,
- 8 implement, and operate research, education, promotion, and
- 9 marketing programs under this subchapter. The council shall [is
- 10 the state beef council qualified to] collect the proceeds of and
- 11 administer in this state the beef check off program established by
- 12 federal law. If the council establishes a beef check off program
- 13 under Section 41.1571, the council shall administer that program.
- SECTION 2. Sections 41.156(a) and (c), Agriculture Code,
- 15 are amended to read as follows:
- 16 (a) The council is composed of 20 members [nominated by the
- 17 council and appointed by the commissioner] as follows:
- 18 (1) three representatives <u>appointed by</u> [of] the Texas
- 19 and Southwestern Cattle Raisers Association;
- 20 (2) three representatives appointed by [of] the Texas
- 21 Cattle Feeders Association;
- 22 (3) three representatives appointed by [ef] the Texas
- 23 Farm Bureau;
- 24 (4) two representatives appointed by $[\frac{\text{of}}{}]$ the

- 1 Independent Cattlemen's Association of Texas;
- 2 (5) two representatives <u>appointed by</u> [of] the Texas
- 3 purebred cattle industry;
- 4 (6) two representatives appointed by [of] the Texas
- 5 dairy industry;
- 6 (7) one representative <u>appointed by</u> [of] the Livestock
- 7 Marketing Association of Texas;
- 8 (8) one representative <u>appointed by</u> [of] meat packer
- 9 and exporter associations;
- 10 (9) one representative <u>appointed</u> by [of] Texas
- 11 CattleWomen; and
- 12 (10) two at-large directors appointed by the chair of
- 13 the council.
- 14 (c) The original appointing authority [commissioner, on
- 15 recommendation of the council, shall fill a vacancy on the council
- 16 by appointment for the unexpired term.
- 17 SECTION 3. Subchapter H, Chapter 41, Agriculture Code, is
- 18 amended by adding Section 41.1571 to read as follows:
- 19 Sec. 41.1571. STATE BEEF CHECK OFF PROGRAM. The council may
- 20 establish and operate a beef check off program.
- 21 SECTION 4. The change in law made by this Act regarding the
- 22 appointment of members of the council does not affect the
- 23 entitlement of a member serving on the committee immediately before
- 24 the effective date of this Act to continue to serve as a member of
- 25 the committee for the remainder of the member's term. The change in
- 26 law applies only to a member appointed on or after the effective
- 27 date of this Act.

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1 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
