A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to increasing the recreational sports fee at Texas State
- 3 University System institutions.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 54.538(a) and (b), Education Code, are
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) If approved by student vote at a system institution, the
- 8 Board of Regents, Texas State University System, may charge each
- 9 student enrolled at such institution a recreational sports fee not
- 10 to exceed $\frac{$200}{}$ [$\frac{$100}{}$] per semester or summer session of 10 weeks or
- 11 longer or \$100 [\$50] per summer session of less than 10 weeks. The
- 12 fee may be used to purchase equipment for and to construct, operate,
- 13 and maintain recreational sports facilities and programs at the
- 14 designated institution.
- 15 (b) The board may increase the recreation fee authorized by
- 16 this section as it considers necessary to operate, maintain,
- 17 improve, and equip recreational sports facilities. The recreation
- 18 <u>fee</u> may not be increased more than 10 percent from one academic year
- 19 to the next unless the increase has been approved by a majority vote
- 20 of those students at the affected institution participating in a
- 21 general student election called for that purpose. The fee may not
- 22 exceed the amounts provided by Subsection (a).
- 23 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies
- 24 beginning with fees imposed for the fall 2013 semester.

- 1 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 2 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 3 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 5 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
