- 2 relating to annual training for certain members of the board of
- 3 directors of an appraisal district.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 5, Tax Code, is amended by adding Section
- 6 5.043 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 5.043. TRAINING OF APPRAISAL DISTRICT DIRECTORS. (a)
- 8 In this section, "open government training" means the courses of
- 9 training required of certain public officials by Sections
- 10 <u>551.005(b)</u> and <u>552.012(d)</u>, <u>Government Code</u>.
- 11 (b) The comptroller, with the assistance of one or more
- 12 commissions as defined by Section 391.002, Local Government Code,
- 13 shall develop an online training course for members of the board of
- 14 directors of an appraisal district. The training must provide
- 15 information relevant to the operation of an appraisal district and
- 16 its board of directors, including an overview of the property tax
- 17 system, a discussion of the duties and responsibilities of a board
- 18 of directors, and a description of the resources available to a
- 19 board. The comptroller shall make the training available on the
- 20 <u>comptroller's Internet website.</u>
- 21 (c) Each member of the board of directors of an appraisal
- 22 <u>district must annually complete both the open government training</u>
- 23 and the training described by Subsection (b). The appraisal
- 24 district shall conduct the training required by this section at the

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- 1 first public meeting of the board during each calendar year. A
- 2 member of the board who does not complete the training at that
- 3 meeting must complete the training during regular business hours at
- 4 the main office of the appraisal district not later than the 30th
- 5 day after the date of that meeting.
- 6 (d) A member of the board of directors who does not complete
- 7 the training in the time and manner prescribed by Subsection (c) is
- 8 ineligible to continue to serve on the board. A new board member
- 9 shall be elected in the manner prescribed by Section 6.03(1) to fill
- 10 the vacancy. A member elected to fill a vacancy must complete the
- 11 training required by Subsection (c) not later than the 30th day
- 12 after the date the member is elected or the member becomes
- 13 ineligible to continue to serve on the board and shall be replaced
- 14 as provided by this subsection.
- 15 (e) This section does not apply to a nonvoting member of the
- 16 board of directors of an appraisal district.
- 17 SECTION 2. The comptroller of public accounts shall make
- 18 available the training course required by Section 5.043, Tax Code,
- 19 as added by this Act, not later than January 1, 2014.
- SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 21 a member of the board of directors of an appraisal district
- 22 appointed or elected for a term that begins on or after January 1,
- 23 2014.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
