(b) The commissioners court of a county may by order apply 1 the county's traffic regulations to a public road in the county that 2 is owned, operated, and maintained by a conservation and 3 reclamation district organized or operating under Section 52, 4 Article III, or Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and 5 located wholly or partly in the county if the commissioners court 6 and the board of the district have entered into an interlocal 7 contract under Section 791.036, Government Code. 8

9 (c) A public road that is subject to an order under 10 <u>Subsection (b) is considered to be a county road for purposes of</u> 11 <u>applying a traffic regulation to the public road.</u>

SECTION 3. Section 251.155(a), Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows:

14 (a) The commissioners court of a county may adopt 15 regulations establishing a system of traffic control devices in 16 restricted traffic zones on:

17 (1) property described by Section 251.151(a); and (2) property abutting a public road that is the subject of an order under Section 251.151(b) if the property is owned by the district that is subject to the order or is a public right-of-way [251.151].

SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
