## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to requirements for open meetings held by videoconference
- 3 call.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 551.001, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subdivision (7) to read as follows:
- 7 <u>(7) "Videoconference call" means a communication</u>
- 8 conducted between two or more persons in which one or more of the
- 9 participants communicate with the other participants through
- 10 duplex audio and video signals transmitted over a telephone
- 11 network, a data network, or the Internet.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 551.127, Government Code, is amended by
- 13 adding Subsections (a-1) and (a-2) and amending Subsections (c),
- 14 (e), (h), and (j) to read as follows:
- 15 <u>(a-1)</u> A member or employee of a governmental body may
- 16 participate remotely in a meeting of the governmental body by means
- 17 of a videoconference call if the video and audio feed of the
- 18 member's or employee's participation, as applicable, is broadcast
- 19 live at the meeting and complies with the provisions of this
- 20 section.
- 21 (a-2) A member of a governmental body who participates in a
- 22 meeting as provided by Subsection (a-1) shall be counted as present
- 23 at the meeting for all purposes.
- 24 (c) A meeting of a [state] governmental body [or a

- 1 governmental body that extends into three or more counties] may be
- 2 held by videoconference call only if:
- 3 (1) the governmental body makes available to the
- 4 public at least one suitable physical space located in or within a
- 5 reasonable distance of the geographic jurisdiction, if any, of the
- 6 governmental body that is equipped with videoconference equipment
- 7 that provides an audio and video display, as well as a camera and
- 8 microphone by which a member of the public can provide testimony or
- 9 otherwise actively participate in the meeting;
- 10 (2) at least one agent of the governmental body is
- 11 present at that physical space to conduct the meeting and
- 12 facilitate public participation during the meeting; and
- 13 (3) any member of the public present at that physical
- 14 space is provided the opportunity to participate in the meeting by
- 15 means of a videoconference call in the same manner as a person who
- 16 <u>is physically present at a meeting of the governmental body that is</u>
- 17 not conducted by videoconference call [a majority of the quorum of
- 18 the governmental body is physically present at one location of the
- 19 meeting].
- 20 (e) The notice of a meeting to be held by videoconference
- 21 call must specify as a location of the meeting the location of the
- 22 physical space described by Subsection (c)(1) [where a quorum of
- 23 the governmental body will be physically present and specify the
- 24 intent to have a quorum present at that location, except that the
- 25 notice of a meeting to be held by videoconference call under
- 26 Subsection (c) must specify as a location of the meeting each
- 27 location where a majority of the quorum of the governmental body

- 1 will be physically present and specify the intent to have a majority
- 2 of the quorum of the governmental body present at that location. In
- 3 addition, the notice of the meeting must specify as a location of
- 4 the meeting each other location where a member of the governmental
- 5 body who will participate in the meeting will be physically present
- 6 during the meeting. Each of the locations shall be open to the
- 7 public during the open portions of the meeting].
- 8 (h) The physical [Each] location specified under Subsection
- 9 (e) shall have two-way audio and video communication with each
- 10 member who is participating by videoconference call [other
- 11 <del>location</del>] during the entire meeting. Each participant in the
- 12 videoconference call, while speaking, shall be clearly visible and
- 13 audible to each other participant and, during the open portion of
- 14 the meeting, to the members of the public in attendance at  $\underline{\text{the}}$
- 15 physical location described by Subsection (e) and at any other  $[\frac{1}{4}]$
- 16 location of the meeting that is open to the public.
- 17 (j) The [quality of the] audio and video signals perceptible
- 18 by members of the public at each location of the meeting described
- 19 by Subsection (h) must[÷
- 20 [(1) meet or exceed the quality of the audio and video
- 21 signals perceptible by the members of the governmental body
- 22 participating in the meeting; and
- [(2)] be of sufficient quality so that members of the
- 24 public at each location [of the meeting] can observe the demeanor
- 25 and hear the voice of each participant in the open portion of the
- 26 meeting.
- 27 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to

- 1 an open meeting held on or after the effective date of this Act. An
- 2 open meeting that is held before the effective date of this Act is
- 3 governed by the law in effect on the date of the open meeting, and
- 4 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
