H.B. No. 2415

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the expiration of a driver's license and to the
3 disposition of fees assessed for the renewal of driver's licenses.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Sections 521.271(a), (a-2), and (b),
6 Transportation Code, are amended to read as follows:

7 (a) Each original driver's license, provisional license,
8 instruction permit, or occupational driver's license issued to an
9 applicant who is a citizen, national, or legal permanent resident
10 of the United States or a refugee or asylee lawfully admitted into
11 the United States expires as follows:

12 (1) except as provided by Section 521.2711, a driver's
13 license expires on the first birthday of the license holder
14 occurring after the fourth [~~sixth~~] anniversary of the date of the
15 application;

16 (2) a provisional license expires on the 18th birthday
17 of the license holder;

18 (3) an instruction permit expires on the 18th birthday
19 of the license holder;

20 (4) an occupational driver's license expires on the
21 first anniversary of the court order granting the license; and

22 (5) unless an earlier date is otherwise provided, a
23 driver's license issued to a person whose residence or domicile is a
24 correctional facility or a parole facility expires on the first

1 birthday of the license holder occurring after the first
2 anniversary of the date of issuance.

3 (a-2) Each original driver's license issued to an applicant
4 who is not a citizen, national, or legal permanent resident of the
5 United States or a refugee or asylee lawfully admitted into the
6 United States expires on:

7 (1) the earlier of:

8 (A) the first birthday of the license holder
9 occurring after the fourth [~~sixth~~] anniversary of the date of the
10 application; or

11 (B) the expiration date of the license holder's
12 lawful presence in the United States as determined by the
13 appropriate United States agency in compliance with federal law; or

14 (2) the first anniversary of the date of issuance, if
15 there is no definite expiration date for the applicant's authorized
16 stay in the United States.

17 (b) Except as provided by Section 521.2711, a driver's
18 license that is renewed expires on the earlier of:

19 (1) the fourth [~~sixth~~] anniversary of the expiration
20 date before renewal if the applicant is a citizen, national, or
21 legal permanent resident of the United States or a refugee or asylee
22 lawfully admitted into the United States;

23 (1-a) for an applicant not described by Subdivision
24 (1):

25 (A) the earlier of:

26 (i) the fourth [~~sixth~~] anniversary of the
27 expiration date before renewal; or

1 (ii) the expiration date of the applicant's
2 authorized stay in the United States; or

3 (B) the first anniversary of the date of
4 issuance, if there is no definite expiration date for the
5 applicant's authorized stay in the United States; or

6 (2) for a renewal driver's license issued to a person
7 whose residence or domicile is a correctional facility or a parole
8 facility, the first birthday of the license holder occurring after
9 the first anniversary of the date of issuance unless an earlier date
10 is otherwise provided.

11 SECTION 2. Section 521.427, Transportation Code, is amended
12 by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:

13 (c) Subsection (a) does not apply to one-third of a fee
14 collected under Section 521.421(a) for renewal of a license. The
15 department shall remit the portion of a fee described by this
16 subsection to the comptroller for deposit to the credit of the state
17 highway fund.

18 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
19 an original or renewal driver's license issued on or after
20 September 1, 2013. An original or renewal driver's license issued
21 before September 1, 2013, is governed by the law as it existed
22 immediately before September 1, 2013, and that law is continued in
23 effect for that purpose.

24 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
