          SECTION 1. Section 123.002, Human Resources Code,

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          Sec. 123.002. DEFINITIONS [DEFINITION]. In this chapter:
                (1) "Department" means the Department of Aging and

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                (3) "Person [<del>,"person</del>] with a disability" means a
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    person whose ability to care for the person's self [himself],

- 5 SECTION 2. Section 123.004, Human Resources Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 123.004. QUALIFICATION AS COMMUNITY HOME. To qualify
- 8 as a community home, an entity must comply with Sections 123.005
- 9 through 123.008 and be:
- 10 (1) a community-based residential home operated by:
- 11 (A) the <u>department</u> [Texas Department of Mental
- 12 Health and Mental Retardation];
- 13 (B) a community center organized under
- 14 Subchapter A, Chapter 534, Health and Safety Code, that provides
- 15 services to persons with disabilities;
- 16 (C) an entity subject to the Texas Nonprofit
- 17 Corporation Law as described by Section 1.008, Business
- 18 Organizations Code [Non-Profit Corporation Act (Article 1396-1.01
- 19 et seq., Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes)]; or
- 20 (D) an entity certified by the <u>Health and</u> [Texas
- 21 Department of Human Services Commission as a provider under the
- 22 medical assistance program serving persons in intermediate care
- 23 facilities for persons with mental retardation; or
- 24 (2) an assisted living facility licensed under Chapter
- 25 247, Health and Safety Code, provided that the exterior structure
- 26 retains compatibility with the surrounding residential dwellings.
- 27 SECTION 3. Section 123.007, Human Resources Code, is

- 2 Sec. 123.007. LICENSING AND REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS. (a)
- 3 A community home must meet all applicable licensing requirements.
- 4 (b) A community home that is not registered, licensed,
- 5 operated, certified, or otherwise regulated by a state agency shall
- 6 register with the department in accordance with rules adopted by
- 7 the executive commissioner.
- 8 SECTION 4. Section 123.008, Human Resources Code, is
- 9 amended to read as follows:
- 10 Sec. 123.008. LOCATION REQUIREMENT. (a) A community home
- 11 may not be established within one-half mile of an existing
- 12 community home.
- (b) The department or another state regulatory agency may
- 14 not operate a community home that is located within one-half mile of
- 15 <u>an existing community home and may not issue or renew a</u>
- 16 registration, license, or certificate to such a home.
- 17 (c) If a community home is registered, licensed, operated,
- 18 certified, or otherwise regulated by the department or another
- 19 state agency under another law, the department or other agency may
- 20 enforce a violation of this section in the same manner the
- 21 <u>department or other agency enforces a violation of that other law.</u>
- 22 (d) The executive commissioner shall adopt rules necessary
- 23 to implement this section.
- SECTION 5. Section 123.010, Human Resources Code, is
- 25 amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 123.010. ENSURING THE SAFETY OF RESIDENTS. The
- 27 department [Texas Department of Mental Health and Mental

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- 1 Retardation] shall make every reasonable effort to ensure the
- 2 safety of community home residents and the residents of a
- 3 neighborhood that is affected by the location of a community home.
- 4 SECTION 6. (a) Not later than January 1, 2014, the executive
- 5 commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission shall
- 6 adopt rules as required by Sections 123.007 and 123.008, Human
- 7 Resources Code, as amended by this Act.
- 8 (b) A community home that is subject to Section 123.007(b),
- 9 Human Resources Code, as added by this Act, is not required to
- 10 register with the Department of Aging and Disability Services as
- 11 required by that section until February 1, 2014.
- 12 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
