- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Chapter 14, Civil Practice and Remedies Code, is
- 5 amended by adding Section 14.0025 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 14.0025. PRE-SUIT DEPOSITION. (a) Upon receipt of an
- 7 inmate's petition for a pre-suit deposition, the court shall
- 8 determine if the potential claim or suit is frivolous or malicious
- 9 and provide the potential defendant with an opportunity to respond
- 10 within a reasonable period of time.
- 11 (b) If the court finds that the potential claim or suit is
- 12 frivolous or malicious, the court shall deny the inmate's petition
- 13 for a deposition.
- 14 (c) To the extent that this section conflicts with the Texas
- 15 Rules of Civil Procedure, this section controls.
- 16 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 17 to a petition for a deposition filed on or after the effective date
- 18 of this Act. A petition filed before the effective date of this Act
- 19 is governed by the law in effect on the date the petition was filed,
- 20 and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
