- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 64.034, Election Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 64.034. OATH. A person selected to provide assistance
- 7 to a voter must take the following oath, administered by an election
- 8 officer at the polling place, before providing assistance:
- 9 "I swear (or affirm) that I will not suggest, by word,
- 10 sign, or gesture, how the voter should vote; I will confine my
- 11 assistance to answering the voter's questions, to stating
- 12 propositions on the ballot, and to naming candidates and, if
- 13 listed, their political parties; [and] I will prepare the voter's
- 14 ballot as the voter directs; and I am not the voter's employer,
- 15 an agent of the voter's employer, or an officer or agent of a
- 16 labor union to which the voter belongs."
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
