- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 64.034. OATH. A person selected to
- 5 provide assistance to a voter must take the following oath,
- 6 administered by an election officers at the polling place,
- 7 before providing assistance:

- 8 "I swear (or affirm) that I will not suggest, by word,
- 9 sign, or gesture, how the voter should vote; I will confine my
- 10 assistance to answering the voter's questions, to stating
- 11 propositions on the ballot, and to naming candidates and, if
- 12 listed, their political parties; [and] I will prepare the voter's
- 13 ballot as the voter directs; and I am not the voter's employer,
- 14 an agent of the voter's employer, or an officer or agent of a
- 15 labor union to which the voter belongs."
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
