## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to including oral health education as part of the coordinated health program for public elementary, middle, and 3 junior high school students. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 SECTION 1. Section 38.013(a), Education Code, is amended to 6 read as follows: 7 (a) The agency shall make available to each school district 8 9 one or more coordinated health programs designed to prevent obesity, cardiovascular disease, oral diseases, and Type 2 diabetes 10 in elementary school, middle school, and junior high school 11 12 students. Each program must provide for coordinating: (1) health education, including oral health 13 14 education; (2) physical education and physical activity; 15 (3) nutrition services; and 16 (4) parental involvement. 17 18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 20 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

22 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
