H.B. No. 2490

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the eligibility of certain providers of laboratory services for health and human services programs. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Chapter 531, Government Code, is amended by 5 adding Section 531.0058 to read as follows: 6 Sec. 531.0058. DIAGNOSTIC LABORATORY SERVICES. 7 (a) Regardless of where specific laboratory services are performed, or 8 9 where a laboratory is physically located, any provider of diagnostic laboratory services shall be eligible to participate in 10 all health and human services programs as an in-state provider if 11 12 the provider, or its parent, subsidiary or affiliated company or companies, individually or in the aggregate, maintain diagnostic 13 14 laboratory operations and employ at least 1000 persons within Texas. 15 16 (b) This section does not impair the commission's authority to refuse enrollment of a provider on the grounds that the provider 17 is otherwise unqualified for enrollment. 18

19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.

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
