5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Chapter 411, Government Code, is amended by
7	adding Subchapter P to read as follows:
8	SUBCHAPTER P. AVAILABILITY OF BLOOD PRESSURE MACHINES
9	IN DRIVER'S LICENSE OFFICES
10	Sec. 411.441. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter:
11	(1) "Blood pressure machine" means a device that
12	measures a person's blood pressure and displays the person's blood
13	pressure reading.
14	(2) "Driver's license" has the meaning assigned by
15	Section 521.001, Transportation Code.
16	Sec. 411.442. BLOOD PRESSURE MACHINE. (a) The department
17	may allow a blood pressure machine to be located in an office
18	authorized to issue driver's licenses in this state.
19	(b) A blood pressure machine described by Subsection (a):
20	(1) must be made available at no cost to the state; and
21	(2) may not display an advertisement.
22	(c) The department may not:
23	(1) require an applicant for a driver's license to
24	obtain a blood pressure reading from a blood pressure machine

- 1 described by Subsection (a) as a condition of being issued a
- 2 driver's license; or
- 3 (2) charge a fee to obtain a blood pressure reading
- 4 from a blood pressure machine described by Subsection (a).
- 5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
