C.S.H.B. No. 2512

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the disclosure of certain information to the secretary
3 of state for use in voter registration or the administration of
4 elections.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Sections 521.044(a) and (c), Transportation
7 Code, are amended to read as follows:

8 (a) Information provided on a driver's license application
9 that relates to the applicant's social security number may be used
10 only by the department or disclosed only to:

11 (1) the child support enforcement division of the
12 attorney general's office;

13 (2) another state entity responsible for enforcing the
14 payment of child support;

15 (3) the United States Selective Service System as
16 provided by Section 521.147; ~~or~~

17 (4) the unclaimed property division of the
18 comptroller's office; or

19 (5) the secretary of state for the purposes of voter
20 registration or the administration of elections.

21 (c) On the request of a state entity responsible for
22 investigating or enforcing the payment of child support or the
23 secretary of state, the department shall disclose information
24 regarding an applicant's social security number.

1 SECTION 2. Section 730.005, Transportation Code, is amended
2 to read as follows:

3 Sec. 730.005. REQUIRED DISCLOSURE. Personal information
4 obtained by an agency in connection with a motor vehicle record
5 shall be disclosed for use in connection with any matter of:

6 (1) motor vehicle or motor vehicle operator safety;

7 (2) motor vehicle theft;

8 (3) motor vehicle emissions;

9 (4) motor vehicle product alterations, recalls, or
10 advisories;

11 (5) performance monitoring of motor vehicles or motor
12 vehicle dealers by a motor vehicle manufacturer;

13 (6) removal of nonowner records from the original
14 owner records of a motor vehicle manufacturer to carry out the
15 purposes of:

16 (A) the Automobile Information Disclosure Act,
17 15 U.S.C. Section 1231 et seq.;

18 (B) 49 U.S.C. Chapters 301, 305, 323, 325, 327,
19 329, and 331;

20 (C) the Anti Car Theft Act of 1992, 18 U.S.C.
21 Sections 553, 981, 982, 2119, 2312, 2313, and 2322, 19 U.S.C.
22 Sections 1646b and 1646c, and 42 U.S.C. Section 3750a et seq., all
23 as amended;

24 (D) the Clean Air Act, 42 U.S.C. Section 7401 et
25 seq., as amended; and

26 (E) any other statute or regulation enacted or
27 adopted under or in relation to a law included in Paragraphs

1 (A)-(D);

2 (7) child support enforcement under Chapter 231,
3 Family Code; ~~or~~

4 (8) enforcement by the Texas Workforce Commission
5 under Title 4, Labor Code; or

6 (9) voter registration or the administration of
7 elections by the secretary of state.

8 SECTION 3. Section 730.007(c), Transportation Code, is
9 amended to read as follows:

10 (c) This section does not:

11 (1) prohibit the disclosure of a person's photographic
12 image to:

13 (A) a law enforcement agency or a criminal
14 justice agency for an official purpose;

15 (B) an agency of this state investigating an
16 alleged violation of a state or federal law relating to the
17 obtaining, selling, or purchasing of a benefit authorized by
18 Chapter 31 or 33, Human Resources Code; ~~or~~

19 (C) an agency of this state investigating an
20 alleged violation of a state or federal law under authority
21 provided by Title 4, Labor Code; or

22 (D) the secretary of state for the purpose of
23 voter registration or the administration of elections; or

24 (2) prevent a court from compelling by subpoena the
25 production of a person's photographic image.

26 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
27 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
3 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
