- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 352, Local Government
- 7 Code, is amended by adding Section 352.083 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 352.083. NOTIFICATION OF OUTDOOR BURNING. (a) In this
- 9 section, "fire department" means a volunteer fire department or a
- 10 department of a municipality or county that provides firefighting
- 11 services.
- 12 (b) The commissioners court of a county by order may require
- 13 a person to notify the fire department that provides firefighting
- 14 services in an area of the county before starting an outdoor fire in
- 15 the area.
- (c) A person commits an offense if the person knowingly or
- 17 intentionally violates an order adopted under Subsection (b). An
- 18 offense under this subsection is a Class C misdemeanor.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
