- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 2161.001(3), Government Code, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (3) "Economically disadvantaged person" means a
- 9 person who is a member of a racial or ethnic group that comprises
- 10 <u>less than 50 percent of the state's population</u> [economically
- 11 disadvantaged because of the person's identification as a member of
- 12 a certain group, including Black Americans, Hispanic Americans,
- 13 women, Asian Pacific Americans, and Native Americans, and who has
- 14 suffered the effects of discriminatory practices or other similar
- 15 insidious circumstances over which the person has no control].
- 16 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 17 to the certification of a business as a historically underutilized
- 18 business under Chapter 2161, Government Code, occurring on or after
- 19 the effective date of this Act. The certification of a business as
- 20 a historically underutilized business occurring before the
- 21 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect at the
- 22 time the certification occurred, and the former law is continued in
- 23 effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
