- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 481.0069, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsections (d) and (e) and adding Subsection (e-1) to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (d) Money in the spaceport trust fund may not be spent
- 9 unless the office certifies to the comptroller:
- 10 (1) that:
- 11 $\underline{\text{(A)}}$ [\frac{\text{(1)}}{\text{)}} a viable business entity has been
- 12 established that:
- 13 $\underline{\text{(i)}}$ [$\frac{\text{(A)}}{\text{A}}$] has a business plan that
- 14 demonstrates that the entity has available the financial,
- 15 managerial, and technical expertise and capability necessary to
- 16 launch and land a reusable launch vehicle; and
- 17 $\underline{\text{(ii)}}$ [\(\frac{\text{(B)}}{\text{B}}\)] has committed to locating its
- 18 facilities at a spaceport in this state;
- 19 $\underline{\text{(B)}}$ [$\frac{\text{(2)}}{\text{)}}$] a development corporation for
- 20 spaceport facilities created under Chapter 507, Local Government
- 21 Code, has established a development plan for the spaceport project
- 22 and has secured at least 90 percent of the funding required for the
- 23 project; and
- (C) $\left[\frac{(3)}{(3)}\right]$ the spaceport or launch operator has

- 1 obtained the appropriate Federal Aviation Administration license;
- 2 <u>or</u>
- 3 (2) that the money will be used to pay for educational
- 4 programs described by Subsection (e)(2).
- 5 (e) Money in the spaceport trust fund may be used only:
- 6 (1) to pay expenditures for the development of
- 7 infrastructure necessary or useful for establishing a spaceport; or
- 8 (2) to pay for educational programs related to the
- 9 <u>aerospace industry</u>, including:
- 10 (A) science, technology, engineering, and
- 11 mathematics courses designed to introduce middle school and high
- 12 <u>school students to the aerospace industry; and</u>
- 13 (B) science and technology competitions,
- 14 <u>including science fairs and robotics competitions</u>.
- 15 (e-1) The office may contract with a development
- 16 corporation for spaceport facilities for the infrastructure
- 17 development.
- 18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
