- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 11.553, Water Code, is amended to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 Sec. 11.553. JURISDICTION OF WATERMASTER. The geographical
- 8 and jurisdictional boundaries of a watermaster acting under this
- 9 subchapter shall be:
- 10 (1) the Concho River segment of the Colorado River
- 11 Basin that includes the Concho River and all of its tributaries,
- 12 downstream on the main stem of the Concho River to a point on the
- 13 Concho River prior to reaching, and upstream of the O. H. Ivie
- 14 Reservoir located at and including the diversion point of
- 15 Certificate of Adjudication No. 14-1393 (River Order No.
- 16 4954450000) in Concho County; and
- 17 (2) the San Saba River segment of the Colorado River
- 18 Basin that includes the San Saba River and all of its tributaries.
- 19 SECTION 2. Section 11.554(c), Water Code, is amended to
- 20 read as follows:
- 21 (c) The watermaster or deputy watermaster may not be:
- 22 (1) a water right holder in the river basin or a
- 23 segment of the river basin under the program's jurisdiction;
- 24 (2) a purchaser of water from a water right holder in

- 1 the river basin or \underline{a} segment of the river basin under the program's
- 2 jurisdiction; or
- 3 (3) a landowner of any land adjacent to \underline{a} [the] river
- 4 or segment of \underline{a} [the] river under the program's jurisdiction.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
