- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 28.008(b) and (c), Education Code, are
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) The vertical teams shall:
- 8 (1) recommend for approval by the commissioner of
- 9 education and the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board college
- 10 readiness standards and expectations that address what students
- 11 must know and be able to do to succeed in entry-level courses
- 12 offered at institutions of higher education;
- 13 (2) evaluate whether the high school curriculum
- 14 requirements under Section 28.002 and other instructional
- 15 requirements serve to prepare students to successfully perform
- 16 college-level course work;
- 17 (3) recommend how the public school curriculum
- 18 requirements can be aligned with college readiness standards and
- 19 expectations;
- 20 (4) develop instructional strategies for teaching
- 21 courses to prepare students to successfully perform college-level
- 22 course work; [and]
- 23 (5) develop or establish minimum standards for
- 24 curricula, professional development materials, and online support

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- 1 materials in English language arts, mathematics, science, and
- 2 social studies, designed for students who need additional
- 3 assistance in preparing to successfully perform college-level
- 4 course work; and
- 5 (6) periodically review and revise the college
- 6 readiness standards and expectations developed under Subdivision
- 7 (1) and recommend revised standards for approval by the
- 8 commissioner of education and the Texas Higher Education
- 9 Coordinating Board.
- 10 (c) The commissioner of education and the Texas Higher
- 11 Education Coordinating Board by rule shall:
- 12 (1) establish the composition and duties of the
- 13 vertical teams established under this section; and
- 14 (2) establish a schedule for the periodic review
- 15 required under Subsection (b)(6), giving consideration to the cycle
- 16 of review and identification under Section 28.002 of the essential
- 17 knowledge and skills of subjects of the required curriculum.
- 18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
