5	SECTION 1. Section 323.004, Health and Safety Code, is
6	amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (a-1),
7	(a-2), and (d) to read as follows:
8	(a) Except as otherwise provided by Subsection (a-2), after
9	[After] a sexual assault survivor arrives at a health care facility
10	following an alleged sexual assault, the facility $shall[\div]$
11	$\left[\frac{(1)}{(1)}\right]$ provide care to the survivor in accordance with

- (a-1) A facility that is not a health care facility 13
- designated in a community-wide plan as the primary health care 14
- facility in the community for treating sexual assault survivors 15
- shall inform the survivor that: 16
- 17 (1) the facility is not the designated facility; and
- (2) the survivor is entitled, at the survivor's 18
- 19 option:
- 20 (A) to receive the care described by Subsection
- 21 (b) at that facility; or
- (B) to be stabilized and to be transferred to and 22
- receive the care described by Subsection (b) at a health care 23

- 11 (d) If telemedicine is used in the treatment described by

- 14 adopted under that section.
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
