4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 531.0998(e), Government Code, is amended
6	to read as follows:
7	(e) Not later than October 1 <u>of each year</u> [ <del>, 2012</del> ], the
8	commission, the Texas Veterans Commission, the Veterans' Land
9	Board, and the Department of Aging and Disability Services
10	collectively shall submit to the <u>legislature, the</u> governor <u>,</u> and the
11	Legislative Budget Board a report describing:
12	(1) <u>interagency progress in identifying</u> [ <del>the</del>
13	frequency] and obtaining Department of Veterans Affairs benefits
14	for veterans receiving Medicaid and other public benefit programs
15	[success with which state agencies have used the system];
16	(2) the number of veterans benefits claims awarded,
17	the total dollar amount of veterans benefits claims awarded, and
18	the costs to the state that were avoided as a result of state
19	agencies' use of the system; [ <del>and</del> ]
20	(3) <u>efforts to expand the use of the system and improve</u>
21	the effectiveness of shifting veterans from Medicaid and other
22	public benefits to Department of Veterans Affairs benefits,
23	including any barriers and how state agencies have addressed those

24 barriers; and

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1 (4) the extent to which the Texas Veterans Commission 2 <u>has targeted specific populations of veterans, including</u> 3 <u>populations in rural counties and in specific age and</u> 4 <u>service-connected disability categories, in order to maximize</u> 5 <u>benefits for veterans and savings to the state</u> [<del>recommendations for</del> 6 <del>future use of the system by state agencies</del>].

7 SECTION 2. Section 531.0998(f), Government Code, is 8 repealed.

9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 13 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
