## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to certain conditions imposed on defendants convicted of
- 3 an offense of graffiti or juveniles adjudicated as having engaged

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 11(k), Article 42.12, Code of Criminal
- 7 Procedure, is amended to read as follows:
- 8 (k) A court granting community supervision to a defendant
- 9 convicted of an offense under Section 28.08, Penal Code, shall
- 10 require as a condition of community supervision that the defendant
- 11 perform:
- 12 (1) at least 20 [15] hours of community service if the
- 13 amount of pecuniary loss resulting from the commission of the
- 14 offense is \$50 or more but less than \$500; or
- 15 (2) at least 40 [<del>30</del>] hours of community service if the
- 16 amount of pecuniary loss resulting from the commission of the
- 17 offense is \$500 or more.
- SECTION 2. Section 54.046(d), Family Code, is amended to
- 19 read as follows:
- 20 (d) If a juvenile court places on probation under Section
- 21 54.04(d) a child adjudicated as having engaged in conduct in
- 22 violation of Section 28.08, Penal Code, in addition to other
- 23 conditions of probation, the court shall order the child to

- 1 (1) at least 20 [15] hours of community service if the
- 2 amount of pecuniary loss resulting from the conduct is \$50 or more
- 3 but less than \$500; or
- 4 (2) at least 40 [30] hours of community service if the
- 5 amount of pecuniary loss resulting from the conduct is \$500 or more.
- 6 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 7 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 8 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 9 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 10 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 11 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 12 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 13 before that date.
- 14 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
