A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 533.0354, Health and Safety Code, is
6	amended by adding Subsections $(a-1)$, $(a-2)$, $(b-1)$, and (f) to read
7	as follows:
8	(a-1) In addition to the services required under Subsection
9	(a), a local mental health authority shall ensure the provision of
10	assessment services, crisis services, and intensive and
11	comprehensive services using disease management practices for
12	children with serious emotional, behavioral, or mental disturbance
13	not described by Subsection (a) and adults with severe mental
14	illness who are experiencing significant functional impairment due
15	to a mental health disorder not described by Subsection (a) that is
16	defined by the Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental
17	Disorders, 5th Edition (DSM-5), including:
18	(1) major depressive disorder, including single
19	episode or recurrent major depressive disorder;
20	(2) post-traumatic stress disorder;
21	(3) schizoaffective disorder, including bipolar and
22	depressive types;
23	(4) obsessive compulsive disorder;
24	(5) anxiety disorder;

1	(6) attention deficit disorder;
2	(7) delusional disorder;
3	(8) bulimia nervosa, anorexia nervosa, or other eating
4	disorders not otherwise specified; or
5	(9) any other diagnosed mental health disorder.
6	(a-2) The local mental health authority shall ensure that
7	individuals described by Subsection (a-1) are engaged with
8	treatment services in the manner described by Subsection (a).
9	(b-1) The department shall require each local mental health
10	authority to incorporate jail diversion strategies into the
11	authority's disease management practices to reduce the involvement
12	of the criminal justice system in managing adults with the
13	following disorders as defined by the Diagnostic and Statistical
14	Manual of Mental Disorders, 5th Edition (DSM-5), who are not
15	described by Subsection (b):
16	(1) post-traumatic stress disorder;
17	(2) schizoaffective disorder, including bipolar and
18	depressive types;
19	(3) anxiety disorder; or
20	(4) delusional disorder.
21	(f) The department may not use any appropriated state money
22	to implement or fund services under Subsection (a-1), (a-2), or
23	<u>(b-1).</u>
24	SECTION 2. The Department of State Health Services may
25	implement Sections $533.0354(a-1)$, $(a-2)$, and $(b-1)$, Health and
26	Safety Code, as added by this Act, only if a new statewide waiver or
27	authorization using local matching funds to fund the additional

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- 1 populations is granted by the appropriate federal agency. If a new
- 2 statewide waiver or authorization is not granted, the department
- 3 may not implement Sections 533.0354(a-1), (a-2), and (b-1), Health
- 4 and Safety Code.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 2014.
