Section 1451.109, Insurance Code, is amended by 5 adding Subsection (e) to read as follows: 6 7 (e) A health insurance policy issuer may not deny payment or reimbursement to, or reimburse at a lower rate, a chiropractor who, 8 9 in accordance with Section 201.451, Occupations Code, delegates to an assistant a task or procedure relating to the provision of a 10 service by the chiropractor that is within the scope of the 11 chiropractor's license, regardless of whether the chiropractor is 12 physically present when the assistant performs the task or 13 14 procedure. SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act to Section 15 16 1451.109, Insurance Code, apply only to a health benefit plan that is delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed on or after the 17 effective date of this Act. A plan delivered, issued for delivery, 18
