- 3 the 4th Edition of the American Medical Association Guides to
- 4 determine the impairment rating of the lumbar spine.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 408.124, Labor Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 408.124. IMPAIRMENT RATING GUIDELINES. (a) An award
- 9 of an impairment income benefit, whether by the commissioner or a
- 10 court, must be based on an impairment rating determined using the
- 11 impairment rating guidelines described by this section.
- 12 (b) For determining the existence and degree of an
- 13 employee's impairment, the division shall use "Guides to the
- 14 Evaluation of Permanent Impairment," third edition, second
- 15 printing, dated February 1989, published by the American Medical
- 16 Association.
- 17 (c) Notwithstanding Subsection (b), the commissioner by
- 18 rule may adopt the fourth edition of the "Guides to the Evaluation
- 19 of Permanent Impairment," published by the American Medical
- 20 Association, or a subsequent edition of those guides, for
- 21 determining the existence and degree of an employee's impairment.
- 22 (d) The Division shall use the range of motion model from
- 23 the fourth edition of the "Guides to the Evaluation of Permanent
- 24 Impairment" to determine impairment for all lumbar injuries rather

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- 1 than the injury or diagnosis-related estimates model regardless of
- 2 the which edition of the Guides the Division adopts pursuant to
- 3 <u>subsection (b) or (c) of this section.</u>
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
