H.B. No. 2641

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the criteria for designation of an area as a reinvestment zone for purposes of tax increment financing. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 311.005(a), Tax Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 (a) To be designated as a reinvestment zone, an area must: (1) substantially arrest or impair the sound growth of 8 9 the municipality or county designating the zone, retard the provision of housing accommodations, or constitute an economic or 10 11 social liability and be a menace to the public health, safety, 12 morals, or welfare in its present condition and use because of the 13 presence of: 14 (A) a substantial number of substandard, slum, deteriorated, or deteriorating structures; 15 16 (B) the predominance of defective or inadequate sidewalk or street layout; 17 18 (C) faulty lot layout in relation to size, adequacy, accessibility, or usefulness; 19 20 (D) unsanitary or unsafe conditions; 21 (E) the deterioration of site other or 22 improvements; tax 23 (F) or special assessment delinquency 24 exceeding the fair value of the land;

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(G) defective or unusual conditions of title;

2 (H) conditions that endanger life or property by3 fire or other cause; or

4 (I) structures, other than single-family 5 residential structures, less than 10 percent of the square footage 6 of which has been used for commercial, industrial, or residential 7 purposes during the preceding 12 years, if the municipality has a 8 population of 100,000 or more;

9 (2) be predominantly open or undeveloped and, because 10 of obsolete platting, deterioration of structures or site 11 improvements, or other factors, substantially impair or arrest the 12 sound growth of the municipality or county;

13 (3) be in a federally assisted new community located 14 in the municipality or county or in an area immediately adjacent to 15 a federally assisted new community; [<del>or</del>]

16 (4) be an area described in a petition requesting that 17 the area be designated as a reinvestment zone, if the petition is 18 submitted to the governing body of the municipality or county by the 19 owners of property constituting at least 50 percent of the 20 appraised value of the property in the area according to the most 21 recent certified appraisal roll for the county in which the area is 22 located; or

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## 1 population of two million or more.

2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
