## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 7.056(e), Education Code, is amended to
5	read as follows:

- 3 (G) removal of a disruptive student from the

- SECTION 2. Section 25.084(a), Education Code, is amended to
- 19 read as follows:
- 20 (a) A school district may operate its schools year-round on
- 21 either a single-track or a multitrack calendar. If a school
- 22 district adopts a year-round system, the district may modify:
- 23 (1) the number of contract days of employees and the
- 24 number of days of operation, including any time required for staff
- 25 development, planning and preparation, and continuing education,
- 26 otherwise required by law;
- 27 (2) testing dates, data reporting, and related

- 1 matters; and
- 2 (3) [the date of the first day of instruction of the
- 3 school year under Section 25.0811 for a school that was operating
- 4 year-round for the 2000-2001 school year; and
- $[\frac{(4)}{(4)}]$  a student's eligibility to participate in
- 6 extracurricular activities when the student's calendar track is not
- 7 in session.
- 8 SECTION 3. Section 151.326(a), Tax Code, is amended to read
- 9 as follows:
- 10 (a) The sale of an article of clothing or footwear designed
- 11 to be worn on or about the human body is exempted from the taxes
- 12 imposed by this chapter if:
- 13 (1) the sales price of the article is less than \$100;
- 14 and
- 15 (2) the sale takes place during a period beginning at
- 16 12:01 a.m. on the third Friday in August [before the eighth day
- 17 preceding the earliest date on which any school district, other
- 18 than a district operating a year-round system, may begin
- 19 instruction for the school year as prescribed by Section
- 20 <del>25.0811(a), Education Code,</del>] and ending at 12 midnight on the
- 21 following Sunday.
- 22 SECTION 4. Section 25.0811, Education Code, is repealed.
- 23 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
