- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 551, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 551.1282 to read as follows:

- 8 INTERNET POSTING OF MEETING MATERIALS AND BROADCAST OF OPEN
- 9 MEETING. (a) This section applies only to the governing board of a
- 10 junior college district with a total student enrollment of more
- 11 than 20,000 in any semester of the preceding academic year.
- 12 (b) A governing board to which this section applies, for any
- 13 regularly scheduled meeting of the governing board for which notice
- 14 is required under this chapter, shall:
- 15 (1) post as early as practicable in advance of the
- 16 meeting on the Internet website of the district any written agenda
- 17 and related supplemental written materials provided by the district
- 18 to the board members for the members' use during the meeting;
- (2) broadcast the meeting, other than any portions of
- 20 the meeting closed to the public as authorized by law, over the
- 21 Internet in the manner prescribed by Section 551.128; and
- 22 (3) record the broadcast and make that recording
- 23 publicly available in an online archive located on the district's
- 24 Internet website.

- 1 (c) Subsection (b)(1) does not apply to written materials
- 2 that the general counsel or other appropriate attorney for the
- 3 <u>district certifies are confidential or may be withheld from public</u>
- 4 disclosure under Chapter 552.
- 5 (d) The governing board of a junior college district is not
- 6 required to comply with the requirements of this section if that
- 7 compliance is not possible because of an act of God, force majeure,
- 8 or a similar cause not reasonably within the governing board's
- 9 control.
- 10 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 11 to a meeting of the governing board of a junior college district for
- 12 which notice is given under Chapter 551, Government Code, on or
- 13 after January 1, 2014.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
