- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 547.501(d), Transportation Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (d) A warning device, including a horn, may not emit:
- 8 (1) a sound that exceeds a decibel level prescribed by
- 9 <u>department rule; or</u>
- 10 $\underline{(2)}$ an unreasonably [$\frac{1}{2}$ harsh sound or a
- 11 whistle.
- 12 SECTION 2. The Department of Public Safety shall adopt the
- 13 rules to implement Section 547.501(d), Transportation Code, as
- 14 amended by this Act, not later than January 1, 2014.
- 15 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act in amending
- 16 Section 547.501(d), Transportation Code, apply only to an offense
- 17 committed on or after the date rules adopted by the department to
- 18 implement that subsection take effect. An offense committed before
- 19 the date the rules take effect is governed by the law in effect on
- 20 the date the offense was committed, and the former law is continued
- 21 in effect for that purpose.
- 22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
