1 AN ACT 2 relating to voluntary registration and regulation of roofing contractors; providing criminal penalties; authorizing a fee. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Title 20, Insurance Code, is amended by adding 5 Chapter 6004 to read as follows: 6 7 CHAPTER 6004. ROOFING CONTRACTORS SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS 8 Sec. 6004.001. SHORT TITLE. This chapter may be cited as 9 the Roofing Contractor Consumer Protection Act. 10 Sec. 6004.002. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter: 11 12 (1) "Roofing contractor": 13 (A) means an individual performing roofing 14 services for the public for compensation who: (i) is operating as an individual or sole 15 16 proprietorship; or (ii) with respect to a business entity: 17 18 (a) is an owner, officer, or director 19 of the business entity; 20 (b) possesses direct or indirect 21 control of not less than, as applicable: (1) <u>10 percent of the voting</u> 22 23 shares of a corporate entity; or 24 (2) \$25,000 of the fair market

1	value of a noncorporate entity;
2	(c) possesses direct or indirect
3	control of the management or policies of the business entity; or
4	(d) has a direct or indirect interest
5	in not less than 10 percent of the profits, proceeds, or capital
6	gains of the business entity; and
7	(B) does not include an individual acting as an
8	engineer licensed under Chapter 1001, Occupations Code, or an
9	architect registered under Chapter 1051, Occupations Code.
10	(2) "Roofing product" means any material commonly used
11	in the construction, installation, or replacement of a commercial
12	or residential roof.
13	(3) "Roofing services" means the installation,
14	construction, maintenance, repair, alteration, or modification of
15	a roofing product for a commercial or residential roof.
16	Sec. 6004.003. CONSTRUCTION OF CHAPTER; CONFLICT WITH OTHER
17	LAW. This chapter shall be construed to be in addition to any
18	required license, certification, or registration of persons in this
19	state. This chapter is not intended to conflict with or affect the
20	authority of any state or local agency, board, or department that
21	administers or enforces any law or ordinance or that establishes,
22	administers, or enforces a policy, rule, qualification, or standard
23	for a trade or profession. This chapter does not require that a
24	roofing contractor be registered under this chapter to engage in
25	the business of providing roofing services in this state.
26	SUBCHAPTER B. POWERS AND DUTIES
27	Sec. 6004.051. ADMINISTRATION. The commissioner shall

1	administer this chapter in accordance with Chapter 36.
2	Sec. 6004.052. VOLUNTARY REGISTRANT DATABASE. The
3	department shall make available on its Internet website a publicly
4	accessible list of roofing contractors who voluntarily elect to
5	register under this chapter. The list must contain the following
6	for each registered roofing contractor:
7	(1) contact information for the contractor;
8	(2) the name of each business entity with respect to
9	which the registrant is described by Section 6004.002(1)(A)(ii);
10	(3) a statement indicating whether the contractor is
11	registered in good standing under this chapter;
12	(4) a summary of known disciplinary action taken
13	against the contractor; and
14	(5) any other information that the commissioner
15	considers relevant.
16	SUBCHAPTER C. VOLUNTARY REGISTRATION
17	Sec. 6004.101. REGISTRATION. (a) A roofing contractor who
18	voluntarily elects to register under this chapter may represent to
19	the public that the contractor is a registered roofing contractor.
20	(b) A registration:
21	(1) is valid only with respect to the individual named
22	on the certificate of registration; and
23	(2) authorizes the registrant to operate under the
24	registration under the business names included in the application
25	for registration.
26	(c) A registration certificate may not be transferred or
27	assigned.

1	Sec. 6004.102. APPLICATION; APPLICATION FEE. (a) An
2	applicant for a registration certificate must:
3	(1) apply to the department on a form prescribed by the
4	commissioner by rule; and
5	(2) submit with the application a nonrefundable
6	application fee established by the commissioner by rule.
7	(b) The commissioner by rule shall specify the information
8	that must be included on an application submitted to the
9	department.
10	Sec. 6004.103. ISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATE. The commissioner
11	shall issue a numbered certificate of registration to an applicant
12	who submits an application and fee in compliance with Section
13	6004.102.
14	Sec. 6004.104. TERM OF REGISTRATION; RENEWAL. (a) A
15	certificate of registration issued under this chapter is valid for
16	one year.
17	(b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), an application for
18	renewal of a certificate of registration must be filed with the
19	department not later than the 30th day before the date the
20	certificate of registration expires. A certificate of registration
21	for which an application for renewal is not timely filed under this
22	subsection is considered not in good standing until the later of the
23	date of the expiration of the certificate of registration under
24	Subsection (d) or the granting of an application described by
25	Subsection (c), if any.
26	(c) A registrant may file an application for renewal not
27	later than the 30th day after the date a certificate of registration

1 <u>expires.</u>

2 <u>(d) A certificate of registration not renewed under</u> 3 <u>Subsection (b) or (c) may not be renewed. The individual may obtain</u> 4 <u>a new certificate of registration by complying with the</u> 5 <u>requirements and procedures for obtaining an initial certificate of</u> 6 registration.

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SUBCHAPTER D. PRACTICE BY ROOFING CONTRACTOR

8 Sec. 6004.151. COMPLIANCE WITH LOCAL REQUIREMENTS. А roofing contractor shall comply with local ordinances 9 and 10 regulations relating to standards and permits for roofing services. Sec. 6004.152. NOTIFICATION OF CHANGE OF INFORMATION. A 11 12 registrant shall timely notify the department of any change to the name, address, business entity, or legal service agent of the 13 14 contractor.

15 <u>Sec. 6004.153. REGISTRATION DURING SUSPENSION OR</u> 16 <u>REVOCATION PROHIBITED. An individual may not obtain another</u> 17 <u>certificate of registration under this chapter during any period in</u> 18 <u>which the individual's certificate of registration is suspended or</u> 19 <u>revoked.</u>

20 <u>Sec. 6004.154. REBATING PROHIBITED. (a) A roofing</u> 21 <u>contractor providing roofing services to be paid by a consumer from</u> 22 <u>the proceeds of the consumer's property insurance policy may not</u> 23 <u>pay or rebate or promise to pay or rebate all or part of any</u> 24 <u>applicable insurance deductible.</u>

25 (b) A roofing contractor that violates Subsection (a)
26 commits an offense. An offense under this subsection is a Class A
27 misdemeanor.

C.S.H.B. No. 2693 1 Sec. 6004.155. CONFLICTS OF INTEREST PROHIBITED. A roofing 2 contractor may not act as an adjuster or advertise to adjust claims for any property for which the contractor is providing or may 3 provide roofing services, regardless of whether the contractor 4 5 holds a license under Chapter 4101 or 4102. 6 Sec. 6004.156. ENGINEERING AND ARCHITECTURE SERVICES 7 PROHIBITED. Unless a roofing contractor holds a license under the 8 applicable chapter, the contractor may not engage or offer or attempt to engage in the practice of: 9 10 (1) engineering regulated under Chapter 1001, 11 Occupations Code; or 12 (2) architecture regulated under Chapter 1051, 13 Occupations Code. Sec. 6004.157. DISPLAY OF CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION 14 15 NUMBER PERMITTED. A registrant may display the certificate of registration number issued to the contractor under Section 16 17 6004.103. Sec. 6004.158. LIABILITY INSURANCE DISCLOSURE. 18 (a) Α 19 roofing contractor shall provide to all consumers solicited by the contractor a written disclosure of whether the contractor carries 20 21 liability insurance coverage for damage or loss arising from the contractor's provision of roofing services. 22 (b) A roofing contractor may not enter into a contract for 23 24 roofing services with a consumer until the contractor provides to the consumer the disclosure described by Subsection (a). 25 26 (c) On request of a consumer, a roofing contractor that carries liability insurance coverage described by Subsection (a) 27

1 shall provide to the consumer a copy of the declarations page of the 2 insurance policy. 3 SUBCHAPTER E. ENFORCEMENT 4 Sec. 6004.201. INVESTIGATION OF COMPLAINTS. (a) The department shall investigate any complaint alleging that a 5 6 voluntary registrant has violated this chapter or a rule adopted 7 under this chapter. (b) A complaint must be filed in a manner prescribed by the 8 department. 9 Sec. 6004.202. CRIMINAL PENALTY. (a) A roofing contractor 10 commits an offense if the contractor: 11 12 (1) violates Section 6004.155 or 6004.158; or (2) represents to the public that the contractor is a 13 14 registered roofing contractor unless the contractor is registered 15 under this chapter and has received from the department confirmation of registration. 16 17 (b) An offense under this section is a Class C misdemeanor. SECTION 2. Not 18 later than February 1, 2014, the commissioner of insurance shall adopt rules and forms necessary to 19 implement Chapter 6004, Insurance Code, as added by this Act. 20 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
