- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter G, Chapter 1303, Occupations Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 1303.305 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 1303.305. HOME INSPECTION REPORT REQUIREMENT AND
- 8 CERTAIN PAYMENT PROHIBITED. (a) A residential service company may
- 9 not require a homeowner, lessor, or renter to provide a home
- 10 inspection report to the company after a residential service
- 11 contract is entered into by the homeowner, lessor, or renter.
- 12 <u>(b) If a residential service company requires a home</u>
- 13 <u>inspection report before a residential service contract is entered</u>
- 14 into and declines the contract, the company may not collect any
- 15 payment from the homeowner, lessor, or buyer.
- 16 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 17 to a contract entered into or renewed on or after the effective date
- 18 of this Act. A contract entered into or renewed before that date is
- 19 governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective date
- 20 of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

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1 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
