FEASIBILITY STUDY ON VETERANS AS SCHOOL SECURITY PERSONNEL. (a) The commission, the Texas Workforce 10 Commission, and the Texas Education Agency shall jointly study the 11 12 feasibility of establishing an interagency program to connect veterans seeking employment in school security positions with 13 14 independent school districts seeking to employ security personnel. (b) Not later than June 1, 2014, the commission, the Texas 15 16 Workforce Commission, and the Texas Education Agency shall report the results of the study, its findings, and any recommendations to 17 the legislature. 18 19 (c) This section expires September 1, 2015. 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
