## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to notice of a sale of surplus or salvage property by 3 counties.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Sections 263.153(a) and (c), Local Government 6 Code, are amended to read as follows:

7 (a) <u>Except as provided by Subsection (c), the</u> [<del>The</del>] 8 commissioners court shall publish notice of a sale of surplus or 9 salvage property in at least one newspaper of general circulation 10 in the county.

11 (c) A county that contracts with an auctioneer licensed 12 under Chapter 1802, Occupations Code, or that authorizes a county employee in the course and scope of the employee's duties, [who uses 13 an Internet auction site offering online bidding through the 14 Internet] to sell surplus or salvage property under this subchapter 15 16 through an Internet auction site offering online bidding through the Internet [having an estimated value of not more than \$500] shall 17 satisfy the notice requirement under this section by posting the 18 property on the site for at least 10 days [unless the property is 19 20 sold before the 10th day].

21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
