- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 49.273(i), Water Code, is amended to 6 read as follows:
- 7 (i) If changes in plans or specifications are necessary
- 8 after the performance of the contract is begun, or if it is
- 9 necessary to decrease or increase the quantity of the work to be
- 10 performed or of the materials, equipment, or supplies to be
- 11 furnished, the board may approve change orders making the changes.
- 12 The board may grant authority to an official or employee
- 13 responsible for purchasing or for administering a contract to
- 14 approve a change order that involves an increase or decrease of
- 15 \$50,000 or less. The aggregate of the change orders may not
- 16 increase the original contract price by more than 25 $[\frac{10}{10}]$
- 17 percent. Additional change orders may be issued only as a result
- 18 of unanticipated conditions encountered during construction,
- 19 repair, or renovation or changes in regulatory criteria or to
- 20 facilitate project coordination with other political entities.
- 21 SECTION 2. Subchapter I, Chapter 49, Water Code, is amended
- 22 by adding Section 49.2731 to read as follows:
- Sec. 49.2731. PROCEDURES FOR ELECTRONIC BIDS. (a) A
- 24 district may receive bids under Section 49.273 through electronic

- 1 transmission if the board of the district adopts rules to ensure the
- 2 identification, security, and confidentiality of electronic bids
- 3 and to ensure that the electronic bids remain effectively unopened
- 4 until the proper time.
- 5 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, an
- 6 electronic bid or proposal is required to be sealed. A provision of
- 7 this chapter that applies to a sealed bid applies to a bid received
- 8 through electronic transmission in accordance with the rules
- 9 adopted under Subsection (a).
- 10 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 11 to a contract entered into on or after the effective date of this
- 12 Act. A contract entered into before the effective date of this Act
- 13 is governed by the law in effect on the date the contract was
- 14 entered into, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 15 purpose.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
