- 2 relating to the establishment of a state plan for Streptococcus

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subtitle D, Title 2, Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Chapter 94A to read as follows:
- 7 CHAPTER 94A. STATE PLAN FOR STREPTOCOCCUS PNEUMONIAE; EDUCATION
- 8 AND PREVENTION PROGRAM
- 9 Sec. 94A.001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "department"
- 10 means the Department of State Health Services.
- 11 Sec. 94A.002. STATE PLAN FOR STREPTOCOCCUS PNEUMONIAE. (a)
- 12 The department, using existing resources and programs to the extent
- 13 possible, shall develop a state plan for prevention and treatment
- 14 of diseases caused by Streptococcus pneumoniae. The plan must
- 15 include strategies for prevention and treatment of diseases caused
- 16 by Streptococcus pneumoniae in specific demographic groups that are
- 17 disproportionately affected by the diseases, including elderly
- 18 persons, children under two years of age, persons living in
- 19 long-term care facilities, persons with a chronic heart or lung
- 20 disease, smokers, and persons with asplenia.
- 21 (b) In developing the plan, the department shall seek the
- 22 input of:
- 23 (1) the public, including members of the public who
- 24 have had diseases caused by Streptococcus pneumoniae;

- 1 (2) each state agency that provides services to
- 2 persons infected with Streptococcus pneumoniae or the functions of
- 3 which otherwise involve diseases caused by Streptococcus
- 4 pneumoniae, including any appropriate health and human services
- 5 agency described by Section 531.001, Government Code, the Employees
- 6 Retirement System of Texas, and the Teacher Retirement System of
- 7 Texas;
- 8 (3) any advisory body that addresses issues related to
- 9 <u>diseases caused by Streptococcus pneumoniae;</u>
- 10 (4) public advocates concerned with issues related to
- 11 diseases caused by Streptococcus pneumoniae;
- 12 (5) providers of services to persons with diseases
- 13 caused by Streptococcus pneumoniae; and
- 14 (6) any statewide professional associations of
- 15 physicians.
- 16 <u>(c) The department shall update the state plan developed</u>
- 17 under this section at least once every five years and may update the
- 18 state plan biennially.
- 19 Sec. 94A.003. STREPTOCOCCUS PNEUMONIAE EDUCATION AND
- 20 PREVENTION PROGRAM. (a) The department shall develop a program to
- 21 heighten awareness and enhance knowledge and understanding of
- 22 Streptococcus pneumoniae.
- 23 (b) The program <u>developed under Subsection (a) must require</u>
- 24 the department to:
- 25 (1) conduct health education, public awareness, and
- 26 community outreach activities to promote public awareness and
- 27 knowledge about the risk factors for, the value of early detection

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- 1 of, available screening services for, and the options available for
- 2 the treatment of diseases caused by Streptococcus pneumoniae; and
- 3 (2) post on the department's Internet website the
- 4 options available for the prevention, treatment, and detection of
- 5 <u>diseases caused by Streptococcus pneumoniae and information on the</u>
- 6 risk factors for, method of transmission of, and value of early
- 7 detection of the diseases.
- 8 <u>(c) The department, using existing resources, may include</u>
- 9 in the program developed under Subsection (a) a study to estimate
- 10 the current and future impact of diseases caused by Streptococcus
- 11 pneumoniae on this state.
- 12 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
