A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to the vaccination against bacterial meningitis of public
- 3 school students and of certain entering students at public and
- 4 private or independent institutions of higher education.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 38.001, Education Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
- 8 <u>(a-1) Each student shall be fully immunized against</u>
- 9 bacterial meningitis, except as provided by Subsection (c). To
- 10 satisfy the requirement of this subsection, a student must show
- 11 proof of a quadrivalent meningococcal conjugate vaccine and a
- 12 booster dose in accordance with the recommended immunization
- 13 <u>schedule adopted by the Department of State Health Services. The</u>
- 14 executive commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission
- 15 shall adopt rules for the implementation of this subsection.
- SECTION 2. Section 51.9192(b), Education Code, is amended
- 17 to read as follows:

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- 18 (b) This section applies only to an entering student at an
- 19 institution of higher education or private or independent
- 20 institution of higher education. This section does not apply to a
- 21 student of an institution who is enrolled only in online or other
- 22 distance education courses or who is 21 [30] years of age or older.
- 23 For purposes of this subsection, "entering student" includes:
- 24 (1) a new student, as defined by Section 51.9191; and

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- 1 (2) a student who previously attended an institution
- 2 of higher education or private or independent institution of higher
- 3 education before January 1, 2012, and who is enrolling in the same
- 4 or another institution of higher education or private or
- 5 independent institution of higher education following a break in
- 6 enrollment of at least one fall or spring semester.
- 7 SECTION 3. Not later than December 1, 2013, the executive
- 8 commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission shall
- 9 adopt the rules necessary to implement Section 38.001(a-1),
- 10 Education Code, as added by this Act.
- SECTION 4. Section 38.001(a-1), Education Code, as added by
- 12 this Act, applies beginning with the 2014-2015 school year.
- 13 SECTION 5. The change in law made by this Act to Section
- 14 51.9192(b), Education Code, applies beginning with entering
- 15 students enrolling in public or private or independent institutions
- 16 of higher education in this state on or after January 1, 2014.
- 17 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect October 1, 2013.
