5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 51.002, Education Code, is amended by

7 adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:

8 <u>(a-1)</u> The governing board of an institution may not claim

sovereign immunity in any lawsuit for a claim arising under a

10 contract paid wholly or partly with money described by Subsection

11 (a), and the institution is liable for damages under that claim to

12 the extent that money described by Subsection (a) available to the

13 institution is unencumbered by preexisting legal obligations.

14 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only

15 to a civil cause of action that accrues on or after the effective

16 date of this Act. An action that accrued before the effective date

17 of this Act is governed by the law in effect at the time the action

18 accrued, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.

19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
