- 2 relating to the conveyance of state property.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Not later than January 1, 2014 the Texas Board of
- 5 Criminal Justice shall convey to the Board of Regents at the Texas
- 6 State University System for use by Sam Houston State University the
- 7 real property described by Subsection (e) of this section.
- 8 (b) The Texas Board of Criminal Justice shall convey the
- 9 property by deed without warranty regarding covenants of title.
- 10 (c) The deed must include a provision that:
- 11 (1) Requires Sam Houston State University to use the
- 12 property primarily for a governmental purpose; and
- 13 (2) indicates that title to the property will
- 14 automatically revert to the Texas Board of Criminal Justice if Sam
- 15 Houston State University fails to use the property primarily for a
- 16 governmental purpose.
- 17 (d) The Texas Board of Criminal Justice shall retain custody
- 18 of the deed after the deed is filed in the real property records of
- 19 Walker County.
- 20 City of Huntsville, P. GRAY SURVEY, Abstract No. 24, Walker County,
- 21 Texas and being out of and a part of a called 515 acre tract as
- 22 described in a Deed from Ed H. Cunningham, et al to the State of
- 23 Texas, dated July 10, 1883 and recorded in Volume Y, Page 181, Deed
- 24 Records, said 78.823 acre tract being more definitely described as

- 1 follows:
- 2 BEGINNING at the northeast corner of a called 5.00 acre
- 3 tract, out of said 515 acre tract, as described in a Deed from the
- 4 Texas Board of Criminal Justice, on behalf of the Texas Department
- 5 of Criminal Justice, to the County of Walker (Veteran's Complex),
- 6 dated October 29, 2003 and recorded in Volume 595, Page 210,
- 7 Official Records, found a 5/8" iron rod with a plastic cap in the
- 8 south right-of-way of State Highway 75, being a 50 foot strip
- 9 (called 3.78 acres) conveyed to the State of Texas in Volume 209,
- 10 Page 707, Deed Records, said iron rod having coordinates of
- 11 N:10263383.58, E:3788833.74 and being the most northerly northwest
- 12 corner of the herein described tract;
- 13 THENCE S83°08'57"E, with the south right-of-way of said S.H.
- 14 75, for a distance of 1245.10 feet to a called angle point of said
- 15 3.78 acre tract (TxDOT Station 79+76.59), set a 5/8" iron rod, with
- 16 a plastic cap;
- 17 THENCE N70°17'06"E, continuing with the south right-of-way of
- 18 said S.H. 75 for a distance of 95.23 feet to its dated February 19,
- 19 1966 and recorded in Volume 198, Page 501, Deed Records, set a 5/8"
- 20 iron rod with a plastic cap for the northeast corner of the herein
- 21 described tract, from which a 5" square concrete monument, found
- 22 for the northeast corner of said 515 acre tract, bears NO2°32'37"W-
- 23 551.88 feet;
- THENCE SO2°32'37"E, with the east line of said 515 acre tract
- 25 and the called west line of said Heaton tract, at 660.0 pass the
- 26 apparent southwest corner of said Heaton tract, continuing for a
- 27 total distance of 2649.68 feet to its intersection with the

- 1 northeast right-of-way of Interstate Highway No. 45, as described
- 2 in "Tract No. 1 (called 55.13 acres)" in a Right of Way Deed from the
- 3 Texas Prison Board to the Texas State Highway Commission, dated
- 4 July 19, 1957 and recorded in Volume 158, Page 177, Deed Records,
- 5 set a 5/8" iron rod with a plastic cap at a fence corner post for the
- 6 southeast corner of the herein described tract, from said iron rod a
- 7 5" square concrete monument, found for the southeast corner of said
- 8 515 acre tract, bears S02°32'37"E- 2574.60 feet;
- 9 THENCE, with the northeast lines of said I.H. 45, as
- 10 presently monumented, the following calls:
- 1). $N47^{\circ}43'50''W-$ 1972.52 feet to a found TxDOT concrete
- 12 monument;
- 13 2). N49°39'48"W- 259.16 feet to a found TxDOT concrete
- 14 monument;
- 15 and 5). $N55^{\circ}10'12"W$, at 356.2 feet pass a point in a creek for the
- 16 south corner of a right-of-way easement (called 2.744 acres) from
- 17 the Texas Board of Criminal Justice to the Texas Transportation
- 18 Commission, dated January 6, 2000 and recorded in Volume 412, Page
- 19 149, Official Records, continuing for a total distance of 404.59
- 20 feet to a 5/8" iron rod, with a plastic cap, set for the southwest
- 21 corner of the herein described tract;
- 22 THENCE N29°54'57"E, crossing said right-of-way easement, at 28.58
- 23 feet pass a northeasterly line of said easement, same being the
- 24 south corner of a called 10.01 acre tract, out of said 515 acre
- 25 tract, as described in a Deed from the County of Walker to the Texas
- 26 Prison Museum, dated July 16, 2001 and recorded in Volume 466, Page
- 27 755, Official Records, continuing with the southeast line of said

- 1 10.01 acre tract, at 171.32 feet pass a point for the west corner of
- 2 a sanitary sewer, drainage and road easement (called 0.455 acre) as
- 3 described in a Deed from the Texas Board of Criminal Justice to the
- 4 County of Walker, dated May 7, 2004 and recorded in Volume 634, Page
- 5 550, Official Records, continuing with the common line of said
- 6 10.01 acre and 0.455 acre tracts, for a total distance of 501.32
- 7 feet to the southwest corner of said County of Walker 5.00 acre
- 8 tract (Veteran's Complex), same being the northwest corner of said
- 9 0.455 acre tract found a 5/8" iron rod with a plastic cap;
- 10 THENCE $N06^{\circ}51'03''E$, with the east line of said 5.00 acre
- 11 tract, for a distance of 375.56 feet to the PLACE OF BEGINNING.
- 12 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
