- 5 SECTION 1. Section 545.412(b), Transportation Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) An offense under this section is a misdemeanor
- 8 punishable by a fine of not more than [\$25 for the first offense and
- 9 not more than] \$250 [for a second or subsequent offense].
- SECTION 2. Section 545.4121(b), Transportation Code, is
- 11 amended to read as follows:
- (b) It is a defense to prosecution of $\underline{a \ first}$ [\underline{an}] offense to
- 13 which this section applies that the defendant provides to the court
- 14 evidence satisfactory to the court that the defendant possesses an
- 15 appropriate child passenger safety seat system for each child
- 16 required to be secured in a child passenger safety seat system under
- 17 Section 545.412(a). The defense does not apply if, at the time of
- 18 the offense, the motor vehicle is involved in an accident.
- 19 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 20 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 21 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 22 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 23 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 24 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the

- 1 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 2 before that date.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
