The change in law made by this Act applies only 7 SECTION 2. to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 8 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 9 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, 10 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For 11 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the 12 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred 13 14 before that date.
