H.B. No. 2810

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the disposition of surplus data processing equipment by
3 the Texas Department of Criminal Justice.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 497.012(b), Government Code, is amended
6 to read as follows:

7 (b) If the department determines that it is economically
8 feasible, the department shall repair or refurbish the surplus or
9 salvage data processing equipment. The department may [~~shall~~] sell
10 the repaired or refurbished data processing equipment to a school
11 district, a state agency, 501c(3), or a political subdivision of
12 the state in that relative order of preference.

13 SECTION 2. Section 497.012(e), Government Code, is
14 repealed.

15 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
19 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
