6	SECTION 1. Section 501.009, Government Code, is amended to

8	Sec. 501.009. VOLUNTEER AND FAITH-BASED ORGANIZATIONS;
9	REPORT. (a) The department shall adopt a policy that requires each
10	warden to identify [actively encourage] volunteer and faith-based
11	organizations <u>that</u> [to] provide [the following] programs for
12	inmates housed in facilities operated by the department. The
13	policy must require each warden to actively encourage volunteer and
14	faith-based organizations to provide the following programs for
15	inmates in the warden's facility:
16	(1) literacy and education programs;
17	(2) life skills programs;
18	(3) job skills programs;
19	(4) parent-training programs;
20	(5) drug and alcohol rehabilitation programs;
21	(6) support group programs;
22	(7) arts and crafts programs; and
23	(8) other programs determined by the department to aid
24	inmates in the transition between confinement and society and to

- 1 reduce incidence of recidivism among inmates.
- 2 (b) The policy must require that each warden submit a report
- 3 to the board not later than December 31 of each year that includes,
- 4 for the preceding fiscal year, a summary of:
- 5 (1) the programs provided to inmates under this
- 6 section; and
- 7 (2) the actions taken by the warden to identify
- 8 volunteer and faith-based organizations willing to provide
- 9 programs to inmates and to encourage those organizations to provide
- 10 programs in the warden's facility.
- 11 SECTION 2. Not later than December 1, 2013, the Texas
- 12 Department of Criminal Justice shall adopt the policy, including a
- 13 schedule for implementing the policy, required by Section 501.009,
- 14 Government Code, as amended by this Act.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
