## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to programs provided by volunteer organizations to inmates
3	in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 501.009, Government Code, is amended to
6	read as follows:
7	Sec. 501.009. VOLUNTEER ORGANIZATIONS; REPORT. (a) The
8	department shall adopt a policy that requires each warden to
9	identify [actively encourage] volunteer and faith-based
10	organizations <u>that</u> [ <del>to</del> ] provide [ <del>the following</del> ] programs for
11	inmates housed in facilities operated by the department. The
12	policy must require each warden to actively encourage volunteer and
13	faith-based organizations to provide the following programs for
14	inmates in the warden's facility:
15	(1) literacy and education programs;
16	(2) life skills programs;
17	(3) job skills programs;
18	(4) parent-training programs;
19	(5) drug and alcohol rehabilitation programs;
20	(6) support group programs;
21	(7) arts and crafts programs; and
22	(8) other programs determined by the department to aid
23	inmates in the transition between confinement and society and to
24	reduce incidence of recidivism among inmates.

- 1 (b) The policy must require that each warden submit a report
- 2 to the board not later than December 31 of each year that includes,
- 3 for the preceding fiscal year, a summary of:
- 4 (1) the programs provided to inmates under this
- 5 section; and
- 6 (2) the actions taken by the warden to identify
- 7 volunteer and faith-based organizations willing to provide
- 8 programs to inmates and to encourage those organizations to provide
- 9 programs in the warden's facility.
- 10 SECTION 2. Not later than December 1, 2013, the Texas
- 11 Department of Criminal Justice shall adopt the policy, including a
- 12 schedule for implementing the policy, required by Section 501.009,
- 13 Government Code, as amended by this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
