## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the execution of a search warrant for taking a blood
- 3 specimen from certain persons in certain intoxication offenses.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 18, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 6 amended by adding Article 18.065 to read as follows:
- 7 Art. 18.065. WARRANT FOR BLOOD SPECIMEN IN INTOXICATION
- 8 OFFENSE MAY BE EXECUTED IN ANY COUNTY. Notwithstanding any other
- 9 law, a warrant issued under Article 18.02(10) to collect a blood
- 10 specimen from a person suspected of committing an intoxication
- 11 offense under Section 49.04, 49.045, 49.05, 49.06, 49.065, 49.07,
- or 49.08, Penal Code, may be executed in any county in this state,
- 13 regardless of the issuing court's jurisdiction.
- 14 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 15 to a search warrant issued on or after the effective date of this
- 16 Act. A search warrant issued before the effective date of this Act
- 17 is governed by the law in effect on the date the warrant was issued,
- 18 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
