A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to fees for the compulsory inspection of motor vehicles;
- 3 authorizing a maximum fee to be charged by an inspection station.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 548.102, Transportation
- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 548.102. [TWO-YEAR] INITIAL INSPECTION PERIOD FOR
- 8 PASSENGER CAR OR LIGHT TRUCK.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 548.102(a), Transportation Code, is
- 10 amended to read as follows:
- 11 (a) The initial inspection period is three [two] years for a
- 12 passenger car or light truck that:
- 13 (1) is sold in this state;
- 14 (2) has not been previously registered in this or
- 15 another state; and
- 16 (3) on the date of sale is of the current or preceding
- 17 model year.
- SECTION 3. Section 548.501, Transportation Code, is amended
- 19 by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (c) and (d) to
- 20 read as follows:
- 21 (a) Except as provided by Sections 548.503 and 548.504, each
- 22 inspection station shall set a reasonable maximum [the] fee for
- 23 inspection of a motor vehicle [other than a moped is \$12.50. The
- 24 fee for inspection of a moped is \$5.75]. If the maximum inspection

- 1 fee set by the inspection station exceeds the recommended maximum
- 2 <u>inspection fee set by the commission under Subsection</u> (d), the
- 3 inspection station must provide written notice to the commission of
- 4 the inspection station's maximum inspection fee. The maximum
- 5 inspection fee must include any amount to be charged [fee] for a
- 6 verification form issued as required by Section 548.256 [is \$1].
- 7 (c) After receiving written notice under Subsection (a),
- 8 the commission may review an inspection station's maximum
- 9 inspection fee to determine whether it is reasonable. In
- 10 determining whether a maximum inspection fee charged by an
- 11 inspection station is reasonable, the commission may consider the
- 12 resources required by the inspection station to perform the
- 13 station's inspection duties under state and federal law. If the
- 14 commission determines that an inspection fee is not reasonable, the
- 15 commission may require the inspection station to reduce the amount
- 16 of the maximum inspection fee the station charges.
- 17 (d) The commission by rule shall establish a statewide
- 18 recommended maximum inspection fee that an inspection station may
- 19 charge for inspection of a motor vehicle.
- SECTION 4. Section 548.503, Transportation Code, is amended
- 21 to read as follows:
- 22 Sec. 548.503. INITIAL [TWO-YEAR] INSPECTION OF PASSENGER
- 23 CAR OR LIGHT TRUCK. (a) The fee for inspection of a passenger car
- 24 or light truck under Section 548.102 shall be set by the department
- 25 by rule on or before September 1 of each year. A fee set by the
- 26 department under this subsection must be based on the costs of
- 27 producing certificates, providing inspections, and administering

- 1 the program, but may not be less than $\frac{34.25}{5}$ [$\frac{21.75}{5}$].
- 2 (b) The department shall require an inspection station to
- 3 make an advance payment of $\frac{$20.25}{}$ [$\frac{$14.75}{}$] for a certificate to be
- 4 issued under this section. Additional payment may not be required
- 5 of the station for the certificate. The inspection station may
- 6 waive the fee due from the owner of the vehicle inspected. A refund
- 7 for an unissued certificate shall be made in the same manner as
- 8 provided for other certificate refunds.
- 9 SECTION 5. Subchapter H, Chapter 548, Transportation Code,
- 10 is amended by adding Section 548.509 to read as follows:
- 11 Sec. 548.509. SIGNS DISPLAYING FEES. An inspection station
- 12 shall post, in an area of the station that is accessible to and
- 13 <u>frequented by the public, a sign or placard stating:</u>
- 14 (1) the maximum fee the inspection station may charge
- 15 for a vehicle safety inspection; and
- 16 (2) the maximum fee the inspection station may charge
- 17 for an emissions test, if required.
- SECTION 6. (a) Not later than October 1, 2013, the Public
- 19 Safety Commission shall adopt any rules necessary to implement
- 20 Section 548.501, Transportation Code, as amended by this Act.
- 21 (b) Section 548.501(a), Transportation Code, as amended by
- 22 this Act, applies only to an inspection of a motor vehicle performed
- 23 on or after October 1, 2013. An inspection performed before October
- 24 1, 2013, is governed by the law in effect on the date the inspection
- 25 was performed, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 26 purpose.
- 27 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
