A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to the establishment of a regional center for public
- 3 safety excellence in the Rio Grande Valley.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 130, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 130.093 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 130.093. REGIONAL CENTER FOR PUBLIC SAFETY EXCELLENCE.
- 8 (a) In this section:
- 9 (1) "Commission" means the Commission on Law
- 10 Enforcement Officer Standards and Education.
- 11 (2) "Regional center" means the regional center for
- 12 public safety excellence established under this section.
- 13 (b) The regional center for public safety excellence is
- 14 established to develop and provide initial and continuing education
- 15 and training, including education and training leading toward an
- 16 associate of applied science degree and basic peace officer
- 17 certification, for law enforcement personnel in the Rio Grande
- 18 <u>Valley.</u>
- 19 (c) South Texas College shall administer the regional
- 20 center in partnership with political subdivisions and
- 21 participating school districts in the Rio Grande Valley. The
- 22 <u>headquarters of the regional center are located at South Texas</u>
- 23 College in Pharr, Texas. The regional center may use property and
- 24 facilities at other locations in Hidalgo County.

- 1 (d) In developing its training programs and courses, the
- 2 regional center shall ensure that the program or course curriculum
- 3 satisfies any requirements imposed by the commission under
- 4 Subchapter F, Chapter 1701, Occupations Code, for the regional
- 5 center to operate as a commission-approved training provider under
- 6 that chapter.
- 7 <u>(e) The commission may authorize reimbursement for a</u>
- 8 political subdivision or state agency for expenses incurred in
- 9 attendance by personnel of the entity at a training program offered
- 10 by the regional center.
- 11 (f) The regional center may solicit and accept gifts and
- 12 grants from any public or private source for purposes of this
- 13 section. The legislature may appropriate money for purposes of
- 14 this section.
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
