1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to the authority of the board of regents of The Texas A&M
1-18 University System to dispose of real property and mineral interests
1-19 under its jurisdiction.
1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
1-21 SECTION 1. Section 85.25(b), Education Code, is amended to
1-22 read as follows:
1-23 (b) The board may grant, sell, lease, or otherwise dispose
1-24 of the lands and mineral interests under its jurisdiction [~~that do~~
1-25 ~~not comprise any portion of the original main campus of Texas A&M~~
1-26 ~~University~~] to other units or agencies of government, or to any
1-27 individual, group of individuals, corporation, or other entity,
1-28 under terms and conditions the board considers [~~it deems~~] best in
1-29 the public interest.
1-30 SECTION 2. Sections 85.25(c) and (d), Education Code, are
1-31 repealed.
1-32 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-33 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-34 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-35 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-36 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.

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
